2025 RIDE365 Updates - The **RIDE365** Chapter Challenge – The 2025 mileage data has been collected as of midnight Dec 31, 2025, and winners will be announced in the spring after the data is analyzed and audited. Winners will be posted on the Harley Owners Group® – Canada Facebook Page. Be sure to follow this page and encourage



your members to follow it as well for all updates as it relates to the Harley Owners Group. When you are ready to start riding in the spring, don't forget to stop into your dealership and have your 2026 starting mileage recorded. Think of **Ride365** as a contest and you must enter by having your starting mileage recorded at the beginning of your riding season and closed at the end of your riding season. **Please note** – you cannot have your starting mileage and closing mileage recorded on the same day. If you do, your entry will not be valid for the **Ride365** program. When the time comes to put away our motorcycles for the winter, don't forget to visit your dealership and have your closing mileage recorded before December 31, 2026, when the contest closes for 2026.



Anniversary or Milestone – If your Chapter will be celebrating an important anniversary or milestone in 2026, be sure to let me know so I can extend the recognition you deserve. In 2026 I have two Chapters that will be celebrating Anniversaries.

- Towing and roadside costs fully covered

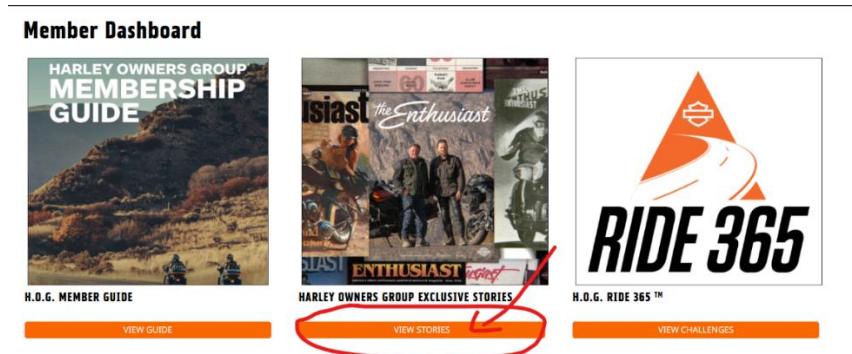
Members needing Roadside Assistance can call 1-888-443-5896, 24 hours a day, 365 days a year.

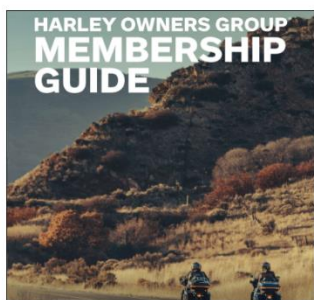
NEW way to send your Adventure Story to HOG® - We have all enjoyed reading the adventure stories in the HOG® Magazine and the Enthusiast Magazine.

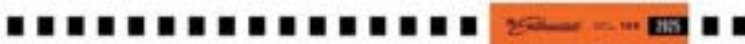

New for 2026 – The HOG® Chapter Recognition Program (I will be meeting and working with my chapters who are interested in participating in the program to hopefully achieve Chrome status on the measures, checkpoints gather we can do this)

HOG Chapters are all about bringing Harley-Davidson riders together to explore great roads, build community, and share the passion for riding. Strong chapters thrive when they're active, inclusive, and well-organized, and we want to celebrate those efforts!

That's where the **Chrome Chapter Recognition Program** comes in. This program highlights and rewards chapters that consistently demonstrate the key behaviors of a successful and healthy HOG Chapter.

How It Works

To earn the Chrome Chapter designation in 2027, chapters must meet all of the following criteria in the 2026 calendar year. If one requirement isn't met, there's still a chance to qualify by completing the Bonus Opportunity.

Requirements to Qualify:

- **Minimum of 30 active members** in the Chapter as reflected in HOG System
- Submit an **Annual Action Plan** to your HOG Regional Director
- At least **50% of members must log 2 (two) or more mileage readings** during the year
- Have a defined process to welcome new Harley-Davidson motorcycle buyers at the dealership to introduce them to the HOG Chapter
- Offer free Chapter membership for the first year to new members
- Host at least 2 (two) rides or 2 (two) events specifically for new Harley-Davidson motorcycle buyers
- Maintain an active social media page (Instagram or Facebook)
- Ensure 100% of members complete the HOG Canada survey (to be sent in Q4 2026) **Bonus Opportunity**: At least 5 active members check in at a HOG Rally or Event.

Recognition & Rewards:

- Official designation as a Chrome Chapter for 2027
- A Chrome Chapter Flag to proudly display
- Chrome Chapter Patches for all members
- Recognition across HOG Canada communication channels



I hope you have enjoyed the Newsletter and updates. I want to thank you all again for your ongoing support. 2026 is shaping up to be an exciting year for HOG® and our members.
